Determination of Cawthorne Parish Council Application to Designate a Neighbourhood Area

The Neighbourhood Planning (General) and Development Management Procedure (Amendment) Regulations (2016) state that where a local planning authority receives an application from a parish council to designate an area that consists of the whole of the parish council's area, the local planning authority must exercise their powers to designate the specified area as a neighbourhood area.

The area proposed by Cawthorne Parish Council is duly designated.
