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# Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. This sets out what we aim to achieve over the next three years to improve outcomes for our customers and the community as we strive to become more customer focused, modern, efficient and business minded.


## **Overall Population**

Up 4.2% since 2011

Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in Cudworth has increased by 4.2%; similar to the rate of increase for Barnsley overall (4.9%). The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more females than males within the ward.




In 2011, 1 in every 100 Cudworth residents' main language was not English; equal to the rate for Barnsley overall.




This is calculated based on seven domains of deprivation, which in turn are composed of a number of indicators that are scored and ranked to produce an overall domain score.















# % of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018




The percentage of pupils resident in the Cudworth ward achieving the expected standard in 2018 decreased and remains below both the Barnsley and national averages.

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

## % of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018




Attainment at the expected standard for pupils resident in the Cudworth ward decreased in all three subjects in 2018 with outcomes being below both the Barnsley and national averages.




# % of Pupils with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities 2018


The percentage of primary school pupils with special educational needs and disabilities increased in the Cudworth ward in 2018 but remained below both the Barnsley and national averages.




The percentage of secondary school pupils with special educational needs and disabilities decreased slightly in the Cudworth ward in 2018, remaining below both the Barnsley and national averages.

## Life Expectancy at Birth




Life expectancy at birth for males in Cudworth is 1.2 years higher than for men in Barnsley.




Life expectancy at birth for women in Cudworth (81.0 years) is lower than the overall Barnsley rate (81.9 years).

# **Under 18's Conceptions**




# Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)



Cudworth's under 75 cancer mortality rate (157.2 per 100,000) is higher than the Barnsley rate of 152.4.




Cudworth's under 75 mortality rate from respiratory diseases (34.8 per 100,000) is lower than the Barnsley rate of 41.8.



# **Excess weight**




The proportion of 4-5 year olds in Cudworth who are overweight or obese (18.2%) is slightly higher than the proportion in Barnsley overall (18.0%).



Over half of women in Cudworth (54.1%) breastfeed their babies at birth; higher than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.



# Smoking



More than one in four adults in Cudworth are smokers. Rates have been consistently higher than the Barnsley rates at each time point during the period 2013 to 2016. However, the current rate of 26.7% is the lowest since 2013.


#### Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)



Cudworth's smoking related deaths rate (346.6 per 100,000 aged 35+) is lower than the Barnsley rate of 353.0 and is the lowest during the period 2011-2013 to 2014-2016.


The 2011 Census showed that 11.8% of households in Cudworth contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.




Almost two thirds of properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in Cudworth. Ownership is higher than both the Barnsley and England rates.









Almost 1 in 5 properties in Cudworth are social rented; lower than the rate for Barnsley and higher than the England rate.

#### **Private Rented**









Cudworth has slightly more private rented properties than Barnsley but fewer than England.

#### **Council Tax Band**





Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more Cudworth households in Band A compared to Barnsley and England.


















There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.

The ASB rate for Cudworth is higher than the England rate, but lower than the Barnsley rate.

All crime figures relate to the period January 2018 to December 2018.









#### Access to a Car or Van




# Mortality Rate from Causes Considered Preventable (rate per 100,000 population)
