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# Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. This sets out what we aim to achieve over the next three years to improve outcomes for our customers and the community as we strive to become more customer focused, modern, efficient and business minded.

To do this, we need a solid evidence base to develop effective interventions which will help to achieve a 'Better Barnsley'.

The data within this report are from the latest available as of May 2018. This information is intended to stimulate discussion, debate and action to support Area Councils and Ward Alliances to identify some of their strategic priorities on an area basis and commission services to meet these challenges.

This profile compares the Ward with the overall Barnsley figure and that of England where possible.

# Demographics

### **Overall Population**

Up 2.2% since 2011

Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in Dearne South has increased by 2.2% compared to 4.9% in Barnsley overall. The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. In Dearne South there are slightly more females than males.




In 2011, 1 in every 100 Dearne South residents' main language was not English; equal to the rate for Barnsley overall.

Barnsley's ethnic diversity continues to change. In the 2011 Census, 3 out of 100 people in Dearne South were from a Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) group compared to 4 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall. The 2011 Census is the most up to date national data available on ethnicity.



This is calculated based on seven domains of deprivation, which in turn are composed of a number of indicators that are scored and ranked to produce an overall domain score.


Proportion of Dearne South Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) in 10% Most Deprived in England






#### The Seven Domains of Deprivation and how Dearne South Performs





The percentage of pupils resident in the Dearne South ward achieving a good level of development increased in 2018 although outcomes remained below both the Barnsley and national averages.


## % of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018



The percentage of pupils resident in Dearne South ward achieving the expected standard increased in 2018 with outcomes now above both the Barnsley and national averages.



### % of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018









### Life Expectancy at Birth




Life expectancy at birth for males in Dearne South is 0.2 years higher than for men in Barnsley. The current rate of 78.3 years is the highest it has been since 2012-2014.





### **Under 18's Conceptions**




Under 18 conception rates in Dearne South have fluctuated during the period 2011 to 2015. The current rate of 53.1 is higher than the Barnsley rate of 33.7, and the highest during the period.


### Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)



Dearne South's under 75 cancer mortality rates have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England at each time point during the period 2010-2012 through to 2015-2017. However, the current rate of 167.9 per 100,000 is the lowest during the period.




Dearne South's under 75 mortality rates from respiratory diseases have fluctuated during the period 2010-2012 through to 2015-2017. The current rate of 58.1 per 100,000 is higher than the Barnsley rate of 41.8 and the second highest during the period.




Dearne South's under 75 mortality rates from cardiovascular diseases have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England at each time point during the period 2010-2012 through to 2015-2017. However, the current rate of 91.4 per 100,000 is the lowest during the period.

### **Excess weight**




The proportion of 4-5 year olds in Dearne South who are overweight or obese (18.8%) is slightly higher than the Proportion in Barnsley overall (18.0%).



Dearne South's rates for 10-11 year olds who are overweight or obese were consistently higher than the overall rates for Barnsley at each time point during the period 2012-2013 to 2016-2017. However, the current rate of 31.2% is now lower than those of Barnsley and England.

### Breastfeeding



46.4% of women in Dearne South breastfeed their babies at birth; lower than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.



More than a quarter of adults in Dearne South are smokers. The current rate of 27.2% is higher than the Barnsley rate of 23.4%, but the lowest since 2013.


#### Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)



Dearne South 's smoking related death rates have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England during the period 2011-2013 through to 2014-2016. However, the current rate is the lowest during the period.

More than one in five women in Dearne South smoke during pregnancy (22.7%); higher than the Barnsley rate of 16.8% and England rate of 10.8%.



### Residents Living Alone and Aged 65+ Years











The 2011 Census showed that 11.0% of households in Dearne South contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.

#### **Owned**








Almost two thirds of properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in Dearne South. Ownership is similar to the Barnsley and England rates.










More than 1 in 6 properties in Dearne South are social rented; this is lower than the Barnsley rate and similar to the England rate.

#### **Private Rented**








Dearne South has more private rented properties than Barnsley; the rate is similar to the England rate.

### **Council Tax Band**





Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more Dearne South households in Band A compared to Barnsley and England.



















There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.

The ASB rate for Dearne South is lower than both the Barnsley and England rates.

All crime figures relate to the period January 2018 to December 2018.






### Access to a Car or Van


### Mortality Rate from Causes Considered Preventable (rate per 100,000 population)
