




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Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. 

Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in Kingstone has increased by 7.2% compared to 4.9% in Barnsley overall. The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more males compared with females within the ward.






In 2011, 5 in every 100 Kingstone residents' main language was not English, compared to 1 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall.

The age profile of the population is changing both locally and nationally. Kingstone has a higher proportion of 19-64 year olds than both Barnsley and England.

Barnsley's ethnic diversity continues to change. In the 2011 Census, 10 out of 100 people in Kingstone were from a Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) group compared to 4 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall. The 2011 Census is the most up to date national data available on ethnicity.






Percentage of Kingstone LSOAs in the Bottom 10% in England by Domain





The percentage of pupils resident in Kingstone ward achieving a good level of development decreased in 2018 with outcomes remaining below both the Barnsley and national averages.


% of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018



The percentage of pupils resident in Kingstone ward achieving the expected standard in phonics screening increased in 2018 and is now above both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018








The percentage of primary school pupils with special educational needs and disabilities in Kingstone ward increased in 2018 and is now just above both the Barnsley and national averages.

Life Expectancy at Birth




Life expectancy at birth for males in Kingstone is 2.2 years lower than for men in Barnsley.





Under 18's Conceptions




Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)






The proportion of 4-5 year olds in Kingstone who are overweight or obese (22.3%) is higher than the proportion in Barnsley overall (18.0%).



61.8% of women in Kingstone breastfeed their babies at birth; higher than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.



More than a quarter of adults in Kingstone are smokers. The current rate of 25.9% is higher than the Barnsley rate of 23.4%, but the lowest since 2013.


Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)




The 2011 Census showed that 11.8% of households in Kingstone contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.








Just over half of properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in Kingstone. Ownership is lower than both the Barnsley and England rates.










One in five properties in Kingstone are social rented; this is similar to the Barnsley and England rates.

Private Rented








Kingstone has more private rented properties than both Barnsley and England.

Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more Kingstone households in Band A compared to Barnsley and England.


















There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.



All crime figures relate to the period January 2018 to December 2018.









Access to a Car or Van


