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## Introduction and Purpose



This profile compares the Ward with the overall Barnsley figure and that of England where possible.



### **Overall Population**




### Age Profile and % of Total Population

Barnsley's ethnic diversity continues to change. In the 2011 Census, 3 out of 100 people in Monk Bretton were from a Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) group compared to 4 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall. The 2011 Census is the most up to date national data available on ethnicity.


## Demographics **Indices of Multiple Deprivation 2015**

LSOAs in 10% Most Deprived in England


LSOAs not in 10% Most Deprived in England





### Percentage of Monk Bretton LSOAs in the Bottom 10% in England by Domain




**Index of Multiple Deprivation 2015 Monk Bretton LSOAs Relative to England** (DCLG, 2015)




### % of Pupils Achieving a Good Level of Development 2013 - 2018

The percentage of pupils resident in the Monk Bretton ward achieving a good level of development decreased in 2018 with outcomes remaining below both the Barnsley and national averages.


### % of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018




The percentage of pupils resident in the Monk Bretton ward achieving the expected standard in 2018 decreased and is now below both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018







### % of Pupils with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities 2018




The percentage of primary school pupils with special educational needs and disabilities increased in the Monk Bretton ward in 2018 and is now above both the Barnsley and national averages.



Life expectancy at birth for males in Monk Bretton is 1 year lower than for men in Barnsley.



### **Under 18's Conceptions**






### Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)



Monk Bretton's under 75 cancer mortality rate (178.3 per 100,000) is higher than the Barnsley rate of 152.4 and is the highest rate since 2010-2012.







### **Excess weight**





### Breastfeeding



Nearly half of women in Monk Bretton (49.3%) breastfeed their babies at birth; lower than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.



## Health and Wellbeing Smoking




Just over a quarter of adults in Monk Bretton are smokers. The current rate of 25.3% is higher than the Barnsley

Monk Bretton's smoking related death rates have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England during the period 2011-2013 through to 2014-2016. However, the current rate is the lowest during the period.

### At Time of Delivery



Almost one in five women in Monk Bretton smoke during pregnancy (19.2%); higher than the rates for Barnsley (16.8%) and England (10.8%).

The 2011 Census showed that 14.6% of households in Monk Bretton contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.


### **Housing Tenure**

Almost one third of properties in Monk Bretton are social rented, this is higher than both Barnsley and England.






Monk Bretton has fewer private rented properties than both Barnsley and England.

Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more Monk Bretton households in Band A compared to Barnsley and England.




### **Total Crime** (rate per 1,000 population)






### Crime (rate per 1,000 population)







There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.

The ASB rate for Monk Bretton is higher than both the Barnsley and England rates.

All crime figures relate to the period January 2018 to December 2018.
















### Access to a Car or Van

### Mortality Rate from Causes Considered Preventable (rate per 100,000 population)






The mortality rate from causes considered preventable in Monk Bretton is slightly higher than the rate for Barnsley.
