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Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. This sets out what we aim to achieve over the next three years to improve outcomes for our customers and the community as we strive to become more customer focused, modern, efficient and business minded.

We're still focused on achieving our three key priorities:

- People achieving their potential
- Strong and resilient communities

We still feel that these areas warrant greater attention, emphasis, and possibly resources, to influence other areas of activity and make the greatest impact overall.

The council will concentrate resources to make the most impact by providing services where they are most needed and we'll help people to do more for each other and their community. To do this, we need a solid evidence base to develop effective interventions which will help to achieve a 'Better Barnsley'.

The data within this report are from the latest available as of May 2018. This information is intended to stimulate discussion, debate and action to support Area Councils and Ward Alliances to identify some of their strategic priorities on an area basis and commission services to meet these challenges.

This profile compares the Ward with the overall Barnsley figure and that of England where possible.

Demographics

Overall Population

Up 3.7% since 2011

Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in North East ward has increased by 3.7%; lower than the rate of increase for Barnsley overall (4.9%). The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more females than males within the ward.



In 2011, 1 in every 100 North East ward residents' main language was not English; equal to the rate for Barnsley overall.


The age profile of the population is changing both locally and nationally. North East ward has a lower proportion of 65+ year olds than both Barnsley and England.

Barnsley's ethnic diversity continues to change. In the 2011 Census, 3 out of 100 people in North East ward were from a Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) group compared to 4 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall. The 2011 Census is the most up to date national data available on ethnicity.



This is calculated based on seven domains of deprivation, which in turn are composed of a number of indicators that are scored and ranked to produce an overall domain score.


Proportion of North East Ward Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) in 10% Most Deprived in England


LSOAs in 10% Most Deprived in England LSOAs not in 10% Most Deprived in England





The percentage of pupils resident in the North East ward achieving a good level of development decreased in 2018 and is now below the national average but remains above the Barnsley average.


% of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018



The percentage of pupils resident in the North East ward achieving the expected standard in 2018 decreased and is now below both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018




The percentage of primary school pupils eligible for and claiming a free school meal in the North East ward decreased slightly but remained above both the Barnsley and national averages.





Life Expectancy at Birth




Life expectancy at birth for women in North East ward is 1.7 years lower than for women in Barnsley.

Under 18's Conceptions




The under 18 conception rate in North East is higher than the overall Barnsley rate. Rates have fluctuated during the period 2011 to 2015.


Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)



North East's under 75 cancer mortality rate (157.7 per 100,000) is higher than the Barnsley rate.





Excess weight




The proportion of 4-5 year olds in North East ward who are overweight or obese (17.9%) is similar to the proportion in Barnsley overall (18.0%). The current rate is the lowest since 2012-2013.



The proportion of 10-11 year olds in North East ward who are overweight or obese (34.4%) is higher than the proportion in Barnsley overall (32.1%). Rates have fluctuated during the period 2012-2013 to 2017-2018.



Just over half of women in North East ward (50.5%) breastfeed their babies at birth; lower than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.



Smoking



More than one in four adults in North East ward are smokers. Rates have been consistently higher than the Barnsley rates at each time point during the period 2013 to 2016. However, the current rate of 26.5% is the lowest since 2013.


Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)



North East 's smoking related death rates have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England during the period 2011-2013 through to 2014-2016. However, the current rate of 376.3 per 100,000 (over 35's) is the lowest during the period.






The 2011 Census showed that 11.3% of households in North East ward contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.









More than 6 in every 10 properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in North East ward. Ownership is similar to the Barnsley and England rates.










More than 1 in 5 properties in North East ward are social rented; this is the same as the Barnsley rate and slighlty higher than the England rate.

Private Rented








North East ward has more private rented properties than Barnsley but fewer than England.

Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more North East ward households in Band A compared to Barnsley and England.





















There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.

The ASB rate for the North East ward is higher than both the Barnsley and England rates.

All crime figures relate to the period January 2018 to December 2018.






Access to a Car or Van




Mortality Rate from Causes Considered Preventable (rate per 100,000 population)
