Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. This profile compares the Ward with the overall Barnsley figure and that of England where possible.

Demographics

Overall Population

Up 4.6% since 2011

Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in Royston has increased by 4.6%; similar to Barnsley overall (4.9%). The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more females than males within the ward.



In 2011, 1 in every 100 Royston residents' main language was not English; equal to the rate for Barnsley overall.


The age profile of the population is changing both locally and nationally. Royston has a slightly higher proportion of 0-18 year olds than both Barnsley and England.




Indices of Multiple Deprivation 2015

Proportion of Royston Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) in 10% Most Deprived in England









The Seven Domains of Deprivation and how Royston Performs





The percentage of pupils resident in the Royston ward achieving a good level of development increased in 2018 with outcomes now above both the Barnsley and national averages.


% of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018



The percentage of pupils resident in the Royston ward achieving the expected standard in 2018 increased but remained below both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018




Attainment at the expected standard for pupils resident in the Royston ward decreased in all three subjects in 2018 with outcomes remaining below both the Barnsley and national averages.






The percentage of primary school pupils eligible for and claiming a free school meal in the Royston ward decreased but remained above both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Pupils with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities 2018




The percentage of primary school pupils with special educational needs and disabilities increased in the Royston ward in 2018 and is now just above the national average and similar to the Barnsley average.



Life Expectancy at Birth






The under 18 conception rate in Royston is lower than the overall Barnsley rate, and is the lowest during the period 2011 to 2015.




Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)



Royston's under 75 cancer mortality rate (137.0 per 100,000) is lower than the Barnsley rate of 152.4.







Excess weight




The proportion of 4-5 year olds in Royston who are overweight or obese (20.2%) is higher than the proportion in Barnsley (18.0%). Rates have fluctuated during the period 2012-2013 to 2017-2018.



Royston's rates for 10-11 year olds who are overweight or obese have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England at each time point during the period 2012-2013 to 2016-2017. However, the current rate of 32.1% is equal to the Barnsley rate and lower than the England rate and is the lowest since 2012-2013.




Over half of women in Royston (59.5%) breastfeed their babies at birth; higher than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.



More than one in five adults in Royston are smokers. Rates have fluctuated during the period 2013 to 2016.


Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)





The 2011 Census showed that 13.4% of households in Barnsley contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.






Two thirds of properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in Royston. Ownership is higher than the Barnsley and England rates.










Just over 1 in 5 properties in Royston are social rented; this is similar to the Barnsley rate and higher than the England rate.

Private Rented








Royston has fewer private rented properties than both Barnsley and England.

Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are slightly more Royston households in Bands B, C and D compared to Barnsley.





















There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.

The ASB rate for Royston is lower than the Barnsley rate and higher than the England rate.

All crime figures relate to the period January 2018 to December 2018.






Access to a Car or Van



In 2011, 25.4% of households in Royston reported that they did not have access to a car or van. This is lower than the rates across Barnsley and England.


