

What to do if hate or harassment is happening to you in Barnsley?






What is hate and harassment?

Any time you or another person is threatened or hurt or experiences abuse because of who you are.

This could be for any reason, including:



your disability

your sexuality

your race

your religion

your age

your sex

being in a violent marriage or civil partnership



Civil Partnership

When two people of the same sex get married.



Types of Hate and Harassment

Hate and Harassment is not always obvious. It can take many forms, some are:

Physical attacks - This would be an attack on a person or damage to something they own.



Threatening behaviour - This would be verbal abuse, swearing and rude gestures.



Bullying - This would be name calling, rude jokes, and deliberately excluding people.





Why we must do something?



Experiencing hate and harassment has a negative effect on the victim's life.

We want to help victims of hate and harassment to improve their quality of life.



The Council, Police, Hospital, NHS, Berneslai Homes and others are working together to stop hate and harassment and to support victims.
