# **Goldthorpe Housing Project Public Consultation, May 2022**

#### **Background:**

In 2021 Barnsley Council commissioned a regeneration specialist, Arcadis, to look at what measures could improve housing in the heart of Goldthorpe, along with the health and wellbeing of residents.

Arcadis produced a high-level Masterplan which presented the potential regeneration options for the Goldthorpe Housing Project area.

Public consultation was carried out to capture views on the potential regeneration options. The survey was targeted towards owner-occupiers, tenants and landlords who live in, or own properties in the Goldthorpe Housing Project area which includes:

Co-operative Street, Victoria Street, Cross Street Beever Street, and Claycliffe Terrace.






via an online survey, paper copy surveys and four face-to-face exhibitions sessions held at Goldthorpe Library, along with home visits upon request. The survey had a 23.5% response rate. The survey results along with written comments received are being used to influence and shape the development of the final proposals for the regeneration of the 'Goldthorpe Housing Project' area. This data provides valuable information about respondents' views and helps us understand the level of support for the proposals and develop them based on the feedback received.
















