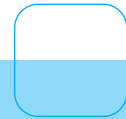
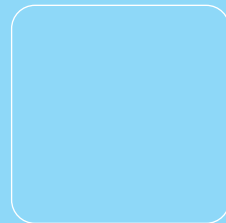


By following four simple steps, you can avoid your alarm causing unintended problems. Make sure:

- 1 your alarm is installed by a qualified engineer and is set to the right level of sensitivity,
- 2 your alarm is well maintained,
- 3 your alarm has a cut-out device. The sounders should cut-out after a maximum of 20 minutes,
- 4 you register the keyholder details for your alarm with the Police and the Pollution Control Team at Barnsley Council. Remember to update everyone if they change. Register more than one keyholder as this improves the chance of the authorities contacting someone in the event of a problem.



Common causes of false activation include electrical storms, decorations or curtains moving in a draught, pets and animals (eg spider webs on alarm sensors). Some alarms ring if the power supply is disrupted so if you use a coin or token meter make sure there is sufficient credit for your electrical power until your return.

Intruder Alarms - important information for holidaymakers

When holidaymakers depart, it is important they make arrangements for someone nearby to hold keys for their house in case their intruder alarm malfunctions.

Alarms attract attention when there is a break-in, but they can also activate if there is a fault. If you are away and your property alarm sounds it may cause intense local disturbance, preventing people from working and sleeping. A persistently sounding alarm can also advertise that your home is vacant.

Barnsley Council and South Yorkshire Police are working to minimise the number of borough residents who return from a well-earned break to find that officers have entered their homes to silence an alarm. This usually means the locks have been changed and the householder is left with a bill for the cost incurred. It's enough to spoil any holiday.
