

## Langsett Parish Council Meeting

28 July 2009

### Minutes

#### *Apologies:*

None. Full Council present: Cllr S Barnes (chair), Cllr L Taylor (vice chair), Cllr L Hammond, Cllr G Hill, Cllr J Key.

#### *Previous Minutes:*

The Clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. These were approved and signed by Cllr Barnes.

#### *Finance:*

The Clerk reported that the annual accounts had been sent to the auditor.

A cheque for the Clerk for £12.00 (postage stamps) was raised.

A cheque for PDNPA for £15.00 (barn rent for the next meeting) was raised.

#### *Planning:*

Application 2009/0725 for a display of advertising panels to the existing bus stop at Manchester Road / Midhopestones Bridge was considered. The Council voted unanimously to object on the same grounds as objections raised to the other application for similar treatment to the bus stop on Manchester Road by the cafe. Clerk to object to BMBC.

#### *Correspondence:*

The Clerk circulated a letter from McMillan Cancer Support acknowledging the Council's donation of £32.00.

Cllr Taylor produced various letters addressed to the previous Clerk. Clerk to ensure the correspondence have up to date contact details for the Council.

The Clerk showed a quote received for £275.00 to supply and fit a galvanized bin at Gilbert Hill picnic site.

*Clerk's Report:*

The Clerk reported that the bin had been ordered and a grant from BMBC applied for.

The matter of verge cutting had been reported to Neighbourhood Pride.

No response from YW and BMBC Estates Dept on Council's comments re. car parking at Langsett Barn and on Manchester Road. Clerk to pursue.

The Clerk reported that the existing minute book was almost full and asked if Council wanted to obtain a new one. Council voted unanimously to continue the practice of maintaining a handwritten minute book as well as computerized minutes on the BMBC website. Clerk to investigate cost and order one.

*Matters Arising:*

Cllr Key raised the issue of drains damage and road flooding on Mortimer Road and stated that the ongoing road surface repairs would be of no use if the drains damage was not addressed also. The existing grates and culverts not taking away water from adjacent fields. Clerk to write to Andrew Milner of BMBC and express these concerns, giving Cllr Key as a contact.
