Other Services (not available at all libraries)

- Foreign Language Material – books for adults & children in languages other than English, some foreign language newspapers & materials to improve your English. All branches have access to the Big Word telephone translation service
- Key Skills Collections – books to help with basic English, Maths & Study Skills
- First Choice & Quick Reads collections – selections of titles aimed at those who are not confident readers
- Self Help collections – self help titles on a wide range of subjects
- Citizenship collections – a selection of titles on life in the UK & titles to help with citizenship. We also have access to "Life in the UK" available online
- LGBT - books of interest to the LGBT community including fiction & books on health, rights, history, biography, legal issues etc.

The Library Service aims to offer services to all groups of people, including those who are unable to access services easily.

Buildings

- Most have disabled toilet facilities & all have portable hearing loops
- There are also 2 Mobile Libraries which are purpose built & have lifts for wheelchair access
- The Central Library has ramped access to meeting rooms. It has a fire alarm system which has both visual & audible warnings. There is also a lift to all floors, with visual & audible floor indicators
- Assistance dogs are permitted in all service points



Home Library Service

If you can't get to the library, then let the library come to you.

The Home Library Service delivers books directly to the homes of those people who are unable to get to a library & have no other way of obtaining library books. The service is free & operates on a monthly basis. Ordinary print books, large print books, spoken word, CDs & DVDs are all available & are chosen to meet individual requirements.

Community Collections

Library staff select & deliver books to residential homes, sheltered accommodation & day centres.

Large Print Books

All libraries (except Kendray) offer a varied selection of books in Large Print.

The Central Library also has a magnifying machine which will magnify the text of ordinary books & the majority of libraries sell magnifying sheets.



Spoken Word

All Libraries (except Kendray) offer a selection of Spoken Word items in either cassette or CD format & these are available free of charge to the visually impaired.



If we don't have the titles you want, then a wider range of titles in various formats, including Braille, can be requested via the interlibrary loan service.



CDs & DVDs

All Libraries (except Kendray) offer a selection of DVDs & music CDs which can be borrowed for a small charge. Many DVDs offer subtitles in various languages as a standard feature.

ICT Facilities

All libraries offer free use of PCs & access to the internet. Screen magnification & voice facilities are available via Windows 2000.



Accessibility equipment such as specialised keyboards, tracker balls, keyboard gloves & wrist supports are also available. The Central Library has a large touch screen PC with internet access which is on a height adjustable table for wheelchair access.



Libraries Online

Many services can be accessed online via the library website. These include joining, searching the catalogue, access to your library account (PIN number required), reservations, online reference resources & Enquire – a 24 hour online enquiry service.
