Brief Site Description
<p>This site lies within the Fields End Business Park in Thurnscoe East. It is roughly square in shape, and bounded by industrial units to the south and west, with Phoenix Park to the north and east.</p> <p>The habitats present on site are secondary in nature. The majority of the site comprises a mosaic of sparse grassland and bare ground on a level, nutrient poor, and poorly drained soil. It is likely that this grassland has developed from a seed mix, as the ground has been artificially levelled in preparation for future development. An earth bund runs along the site's eastern and southern sides. This bund has been planted with a variety of tree and shrub species.</p>

<p>With reference to the data search, no significant issues for protected or priority species have arisen for this site.</p> <p>Figure 1 shows the Phase 1 Habitat map for the site. No areas with significant ecological value have been identified.</p>

Site Description

This site lies within the Fields End Business Park in Thurnscoe East. It is roughly square in shape, and bounded by industrial units to the south and west, with Phoenix Park to the north and east.

The habitats present on site are secondary in nature. In particular, the grassland over much of the site appears recent in origin, the ground having been artificially levelled in preparation for future development. An earth bund runs along the site's eastern and southern sides. This bund has been planted with a variety of tree and shrub species.

The majority of the site comprises a mosaic of sparse grassland and bare ground on a level, nutrient poor, and poorly drained soil. This grassland is dominated by fine-leaved grass species, including Red Fescue (*Festuca rubra*), Crested dog's tail (*Cynosaurus cristatus*) and Creeping Bent (*Agrostis stolonifera*), with abundant White Clover (*Trifolium repens*), Creeping Buttercup (*Ranunculus repens*) and Ribwort Plantain (*Plantago lanceolata*). Oxeye Daisy (*Leucanthemum vulgare*) was also recorded, suggesting that the ground was seeded with a wildflower mix following levelling.

Due to the compaction of the soil (presumably during levelling) the site drains poorly. Hard Rush (*Juncus inflexus*), Sharp-flowered Rush (*J. acutiflorus*) and Common Reed (*Phragmites australis*) are locally frequent in seasonally wet areas. Other plants associated with wet conditions, such as Mint (*Mentha* sp.) and Common Sedge (*Carex nigra*) are present on site.

The earth banking to the south and east of the site is young plantation woodland, with a mix of Scots Pine (*Pinus sylvestris*), Silver Birch (*Betula pendula*), Hawthorn (*Crataegus monogyna*) and Willow (*Salix* sp.) The canopy is not closed and rank grassland and Bramble (*Rubus fruticosus*) provide ground cover.

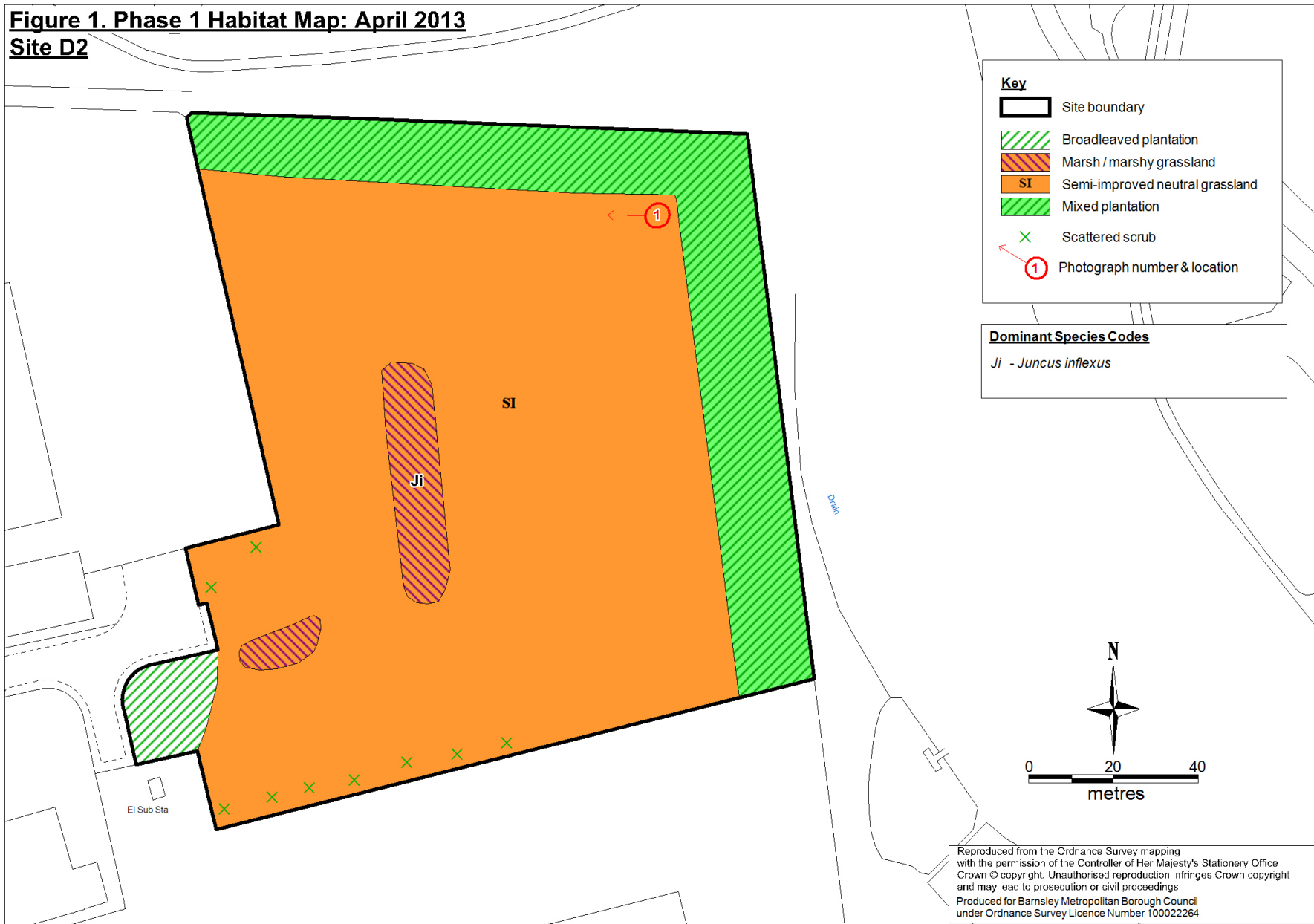
