Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I am submitting this request under the Freedom of Information Act 2000. I would like to request the following information relating to asylum seekers and/or migrants within the Barnsley Council area:

1. The number of asylum seekers (and/or individuals classed as illegal migrants) currently housed in hotels within Barnsley.

Zero; there are NO asylum hotels in Barnsley.

The term 'illegal migrant' is used to describe those who enter the UK by irregular means such as small boat crossings, rather than on Government approved routes. Once in the asylum claim is made, all are recorded as 'asylum seekers' and it is not possible to differentiate on the route of arrival.

2. The number of asylum seekers (and/or individuals classed as illegal migrants) currently housed in other forms of accommodation, such as residential housing or Houses in Multiple Occupation (HMOs), within Barnsley.

The cost associated with asylum seekers is the responsibility of the Government Home Office and is not part of Local Authority budgets.

5. The number and location (by postcode sector) of hotels currently being used to house asylum seekers in Barnsley.

Zero; there are NO asylum hotels in Barnsley.

6. Copies or details of contracts Barnsley Council holds with private companies or hotels for providing accommodation to asylum seekers, including provider names where disclosure is not commercially sensitive.

Barnsley Council does NOT hold any contracts relating to accommodation for asylum seekers. The contract for housing provision is between the Government Home Office and Mears Group PLC. Barnsley Council does not hold the contract information.

7. The number of school places allocated to children of asylum seekers in Barnslev in the last 12 months.

We do not hold this information. Parents do not have to submit this information unless they choose to, therefore data is not collated.
