



Do you think a child is at risk of abuse?

If you suspect that a child is being abused then you have a duty to report your concerns to Children, Young People and Families Child Assessment Team.

In Barnsley there is one Assessment Team, which is your initial contact.

To report your concerns of a child at risk of abuse, call:

The Child Assessment Service (screening): **01226 772423**

Disabled Children's Team: **01226 774050**

Opening Hours: 8.45 am to 5.00 pm Monday to Thursday, 8.45 am to 4.30 pm Friday

For urgent referrals out of these hours call the Emergency Duty Team: **01226 787789**

If you are not sure whether your concerns constitute child abuse you should feel free to discuss your concerns with the Assessment Team on the details above. (Must be sent securely)

Are you concerned that someone who works with children poses a risk? Whether they're an employee, self-employed, volunteer, apprentice or student working with children.

To report any concerns of a child being at risk of abuse, by someone that works with children, you should inform the Local Authority Designated Officer immediately on:

The Local Authority Designated Officer (LADO): **01226 772341.**

Contact MUST be made before an investigation commences. If the LADO is unavailable then please contact the Safeguarding Unit on: **01226 772400.** ALL allegations must be reported to Ofsted.
