Every year we look at what we have done and what we can do better.

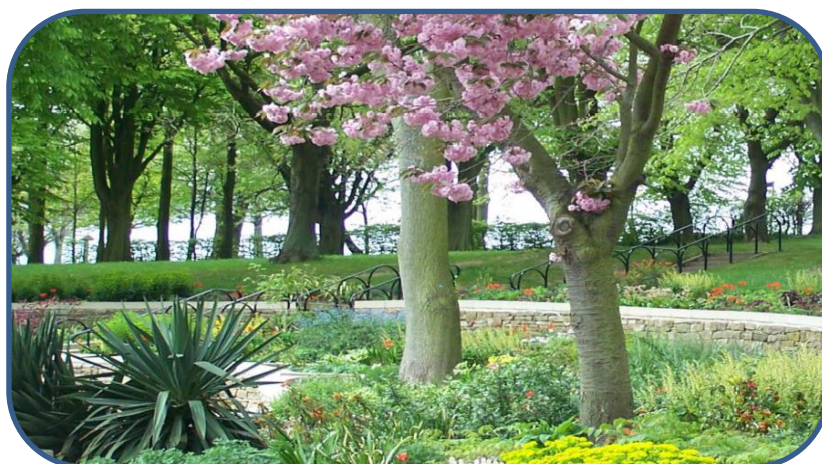


We ask you to tell us what makes you feel safe.
