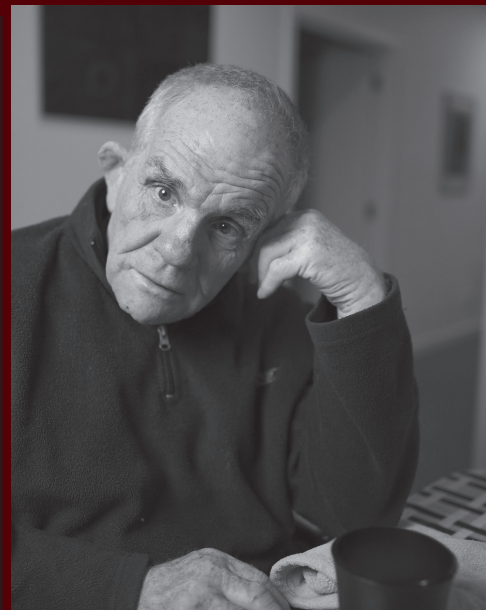

Who is an adult at risk?

Someone aged 18 and over who may need help to keep themselves safe or to stop someone harming them because they have a disability, illness, mental ill health etc.

Adults may be harmed by:

- Neglect
- Physical abuse
- Financial abuse
- Sexual abuse
- Emotional harm
- Discriminatory abuse
- Institutional abuse

Who abuses and where does it happen?

- Anyone can hurt an adult.
- Abuse can happen anywhere e.g. in someone's home, a residential or nursing home, day centres, hospitals or in the community.
