What's working well?

Looking at how different organisations can help people who might be at risk of abuse or neglect to be less likely to be lonely or isolated.

What we are thinking about'

How we help care homes and support to live at home services to prevent and treat pressure ulcers and how this links with safeguarding people at risk.

What action has been taken?

Guidance is being developed with care homes and support to live at home services.
