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LIFE EXPECTANCY AT BIRTH: MALES



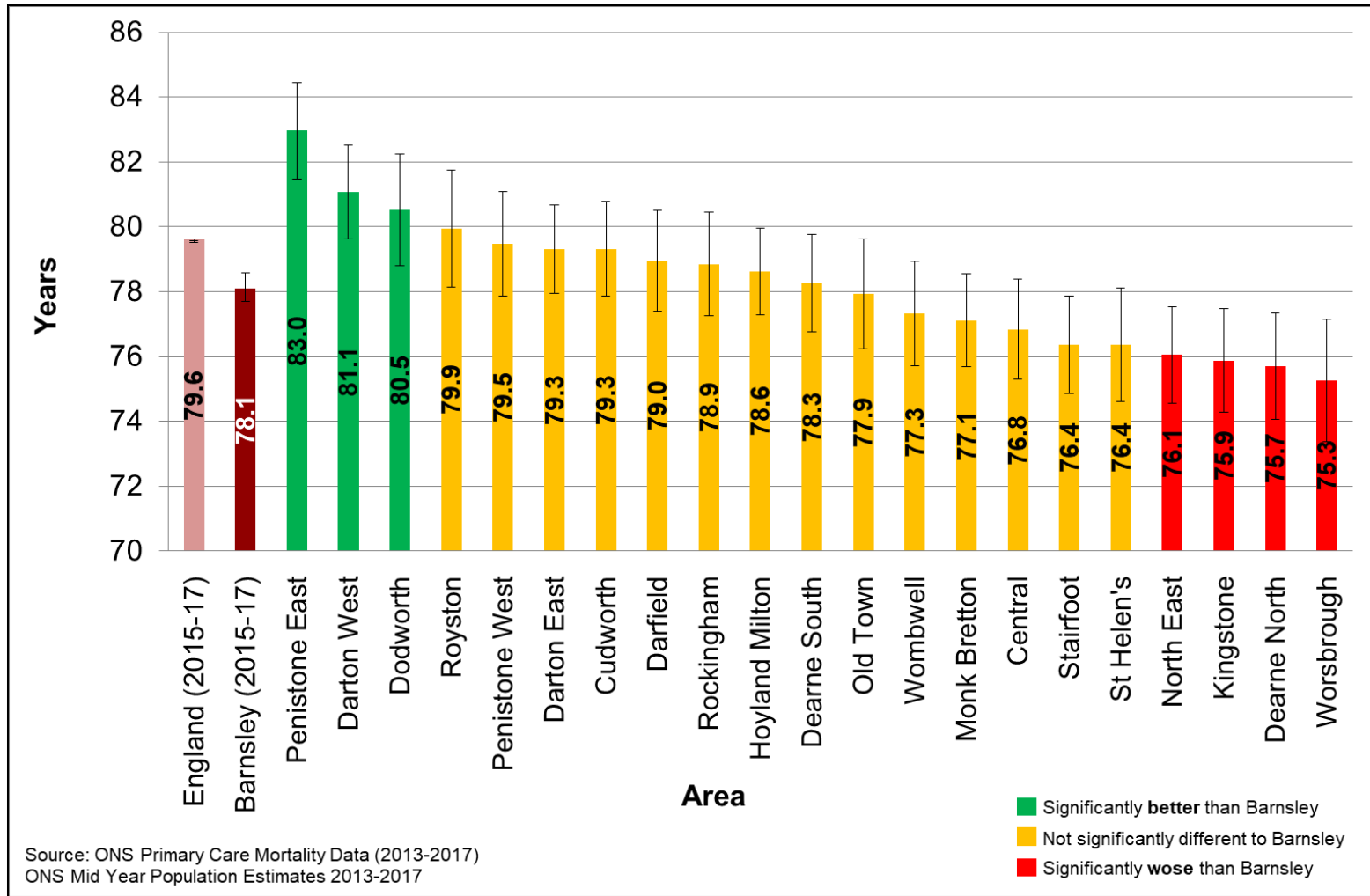
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KEY POINTS: MALES

- For males in Barnsley, life expectancy at birth rates range from 75.3 years in Worsbrough ward to 83.0 years in Penistone East (a gap of 7.7 years).
- Three wards (Penistone East, Darton West and Dodworth) have significantly better rates than the 2013-2017 Barnsley average; four wards (North East, Kingstone, Dearne North and Worsbrough) have significantly worse rates.
- Life expectancy rates in 12 wards were higher in 2013-2017 than in 2010-2014; the largest increase being seen in Wombwell ward (1.9 years).
- Rates in nine wards (Central, Kingstone, Monk Bretton, North East, Old Town, Penistone West, Royston, Stairfoot and Worsbrough) were lower in 2013-2017 than in 2010-2014; the largest decrease being seen in Penistone West ward (-2 years).
- The gap within Barnsley, between the ward with the best male life expectancy at birth and the ward with the worst, has increased by 0.9 years during the period 2010-2014 to 2013-2017, but the increase is not statistically significant.



Life expectancy at birth for males in Barnsley wards: 2013-2017



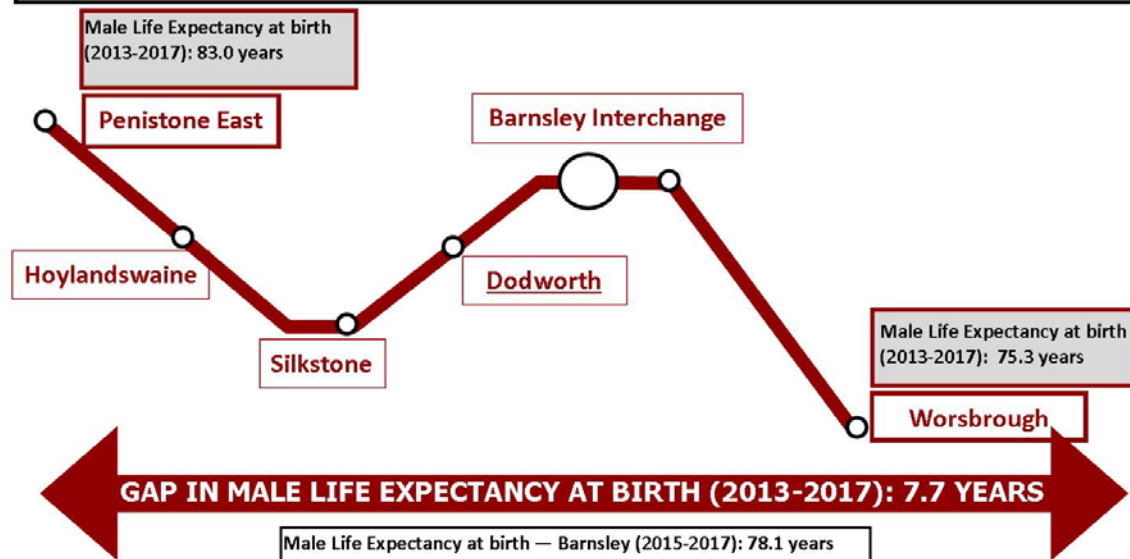

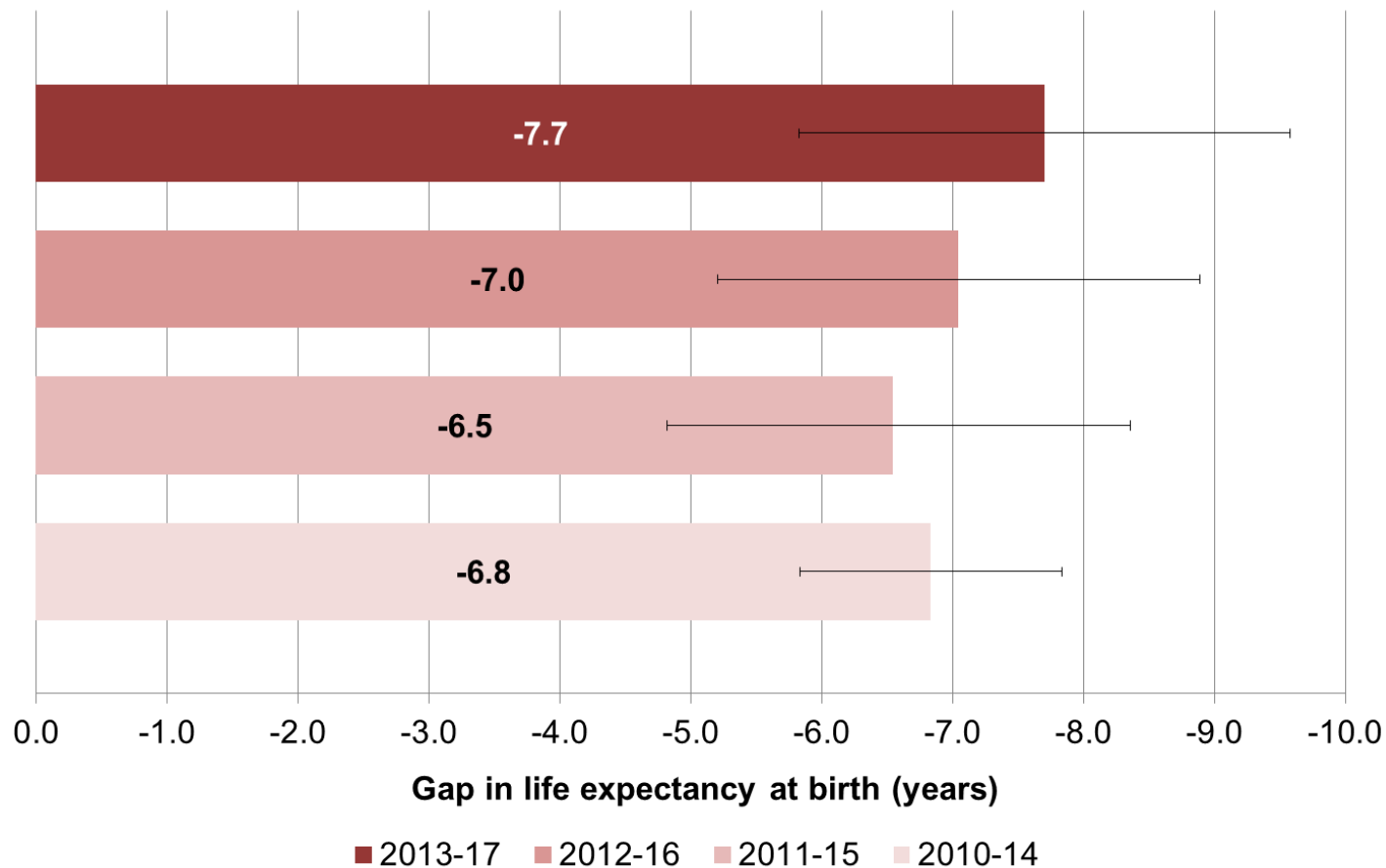

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LIFE EXPECTANCY AT BIRTH: FEMALES



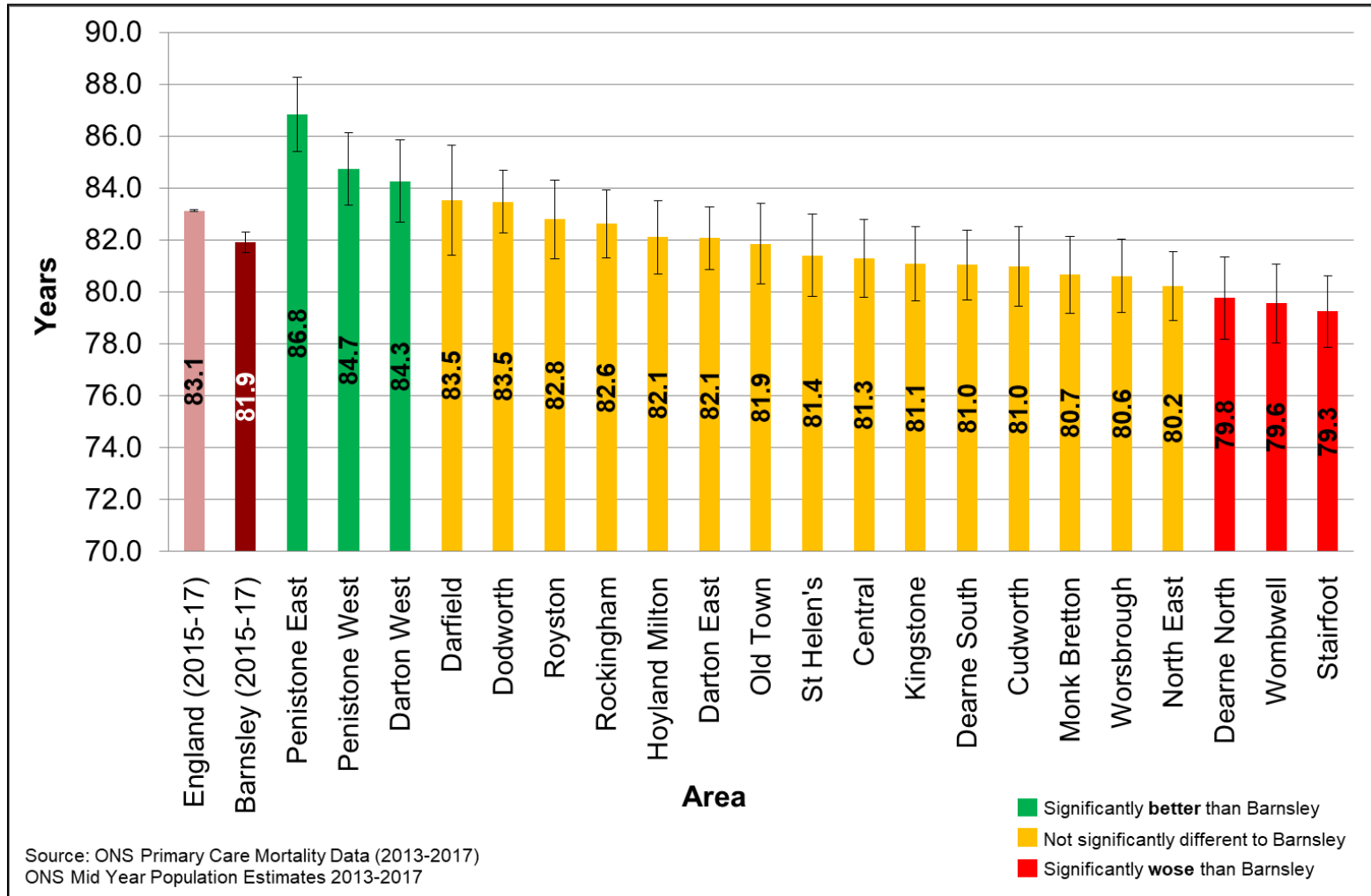
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KEY POINTS: FEMALES

- For females in Barnsley, life expectancy at birth rates range from 79.3 years in Stairfoot ward to 86.8 years in Penistone East (a gap of 7.5 years).
- Three wards (Penistone East, Penistone West and Darton West) have significantly better rates than the 2015-2017 Barnsley average; three wards (Dearne North, Wombwell and Stairfoot) have significantly worse rates.
- Life expectancy rates in 12 wards were higher in 2013-2017 than in 2010-2014; the largest increase being seen in Dodworth ward (2.2 years).
- Rates in seven wards (Central, Cudworth, Kingstone, Old Town, St Helens, Stairfoot and Worsbrough) were lower in 2013-2017 than in 2010-2014; the largest decrease being seen in Stairfoot ward (-1 year).
- The gap within Barnsley, between the ward with the best female life expectancy at birth and the ward with the worst, has increased by 1.2 years during the period 2010-2014 to 2013-2017, but the increase is not statistically significant.



Life expectancy at birth for females in Barnsley wards: 2013-2017



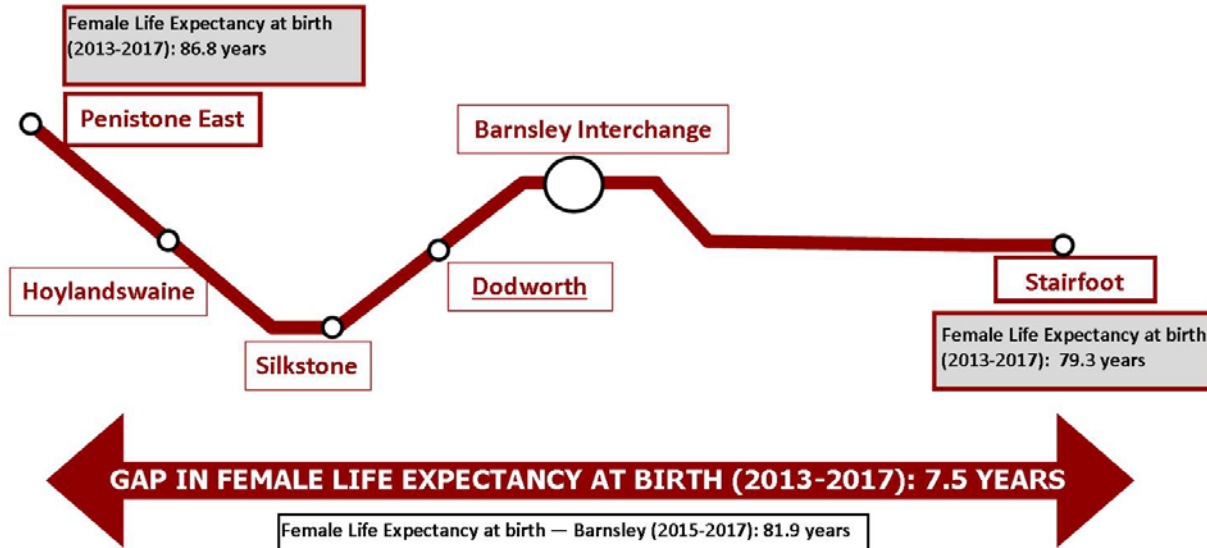

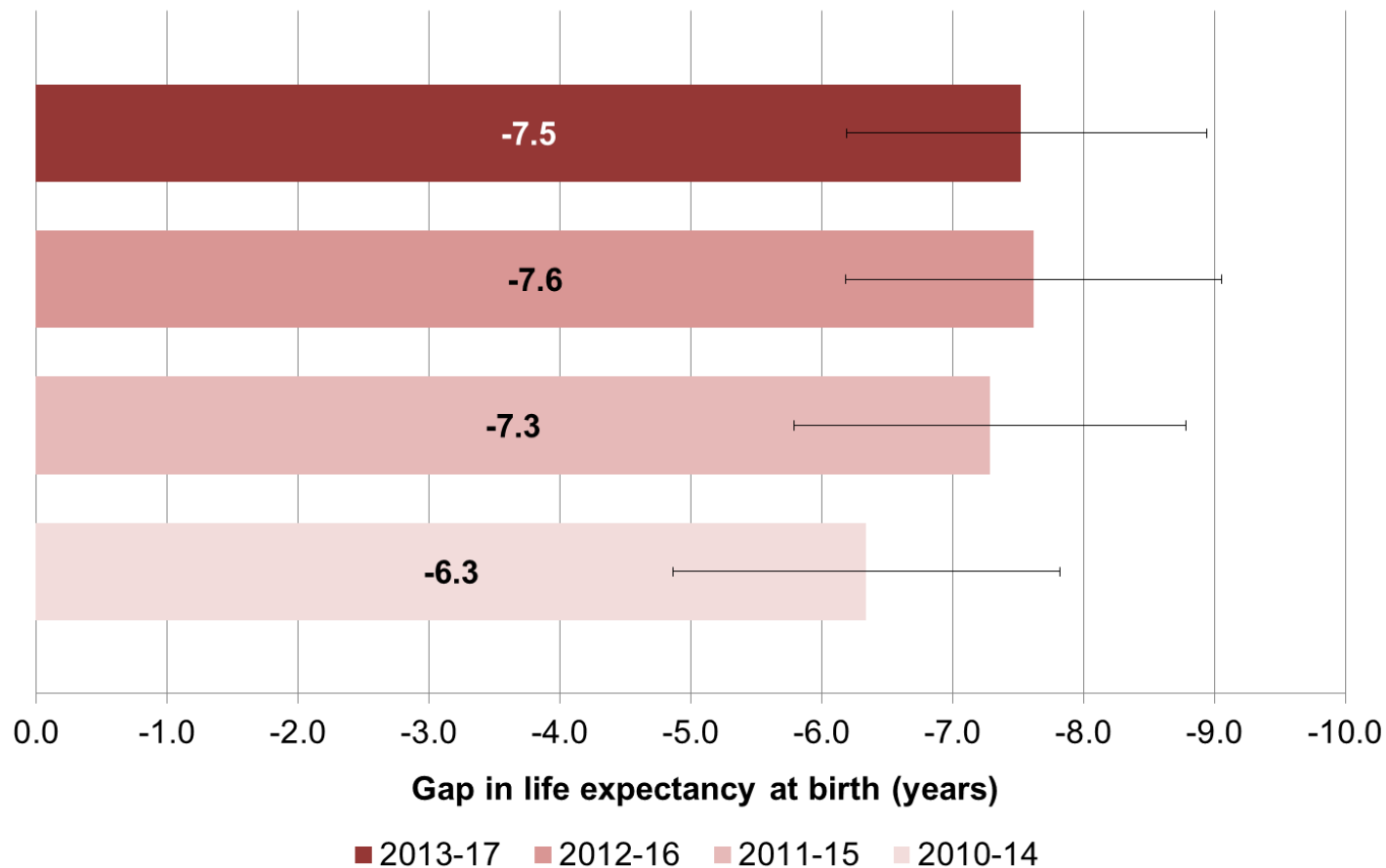
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Change in the gap in life expectancy at birth for females in Barnsley wards: 2010-14 to 2013-17
