Determination of Oxspring Parish Council Application to Designate an Amended Neighbourhood Area

The Application Oxspring Parish Council made an application to the Council for the designation of a Neighbourhood Area on 22 December 2014. The application was subject to a six week period of consultation, from Friday 16 January to Friday 27 February. The application was publicised by means of an advertisement in the Barnsley Chronicle on Friday 16 January, a dedicated webpage on the Council's website and a link from the front page of the Council's website.

One objection was received. This proposed a further extension to the Neighbourhood Area. This has been rejected by both Hunshelf Parish Council (in whose area the further extension is sited) and by Oxspring Parish Council (who propose to be the lead authority for the production of a Neighbourhood Plan for the area proposed). In accordance with Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act, the local authority may only agree to designate the amended area promoted by the objector if Hunshelf Parish Council were to confirm their approval. They have confirmed in writing that they do not agree to the further extension. The Council may not agree the amended area promoted by the objector.

The area proposed by Oxspring Parish Council is appropriate in planning terms and the area is duly designated.
