Decision Statement – Cawthorne Neighbourhood Development Plan

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 & The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012

Regulation 18 Decision Statement

1. Summary

- 1.1. Following an independent examination, modifications are being made to the Cawthorne Neighbourhood Development Plan as set out in Table 1 below.
- 1.2. In accordance with the Independent Examiner's recommendations, the Cawthorne Neighbourhood Plan will proceed to referendum based on the Cawthorne Neighbourhood Area as designated by Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council on 3 May 2017.
- 1.3. At the time of this decision government legislation in the Coronavirus Act 2020 (section 61) and the associated regulations indicate that any neighbourhood planning referendum which would otherwise have been held between 16 March 2020 and 5 May 2021 is to be held instead on the ordinary day of election in 2021 (i.e. 6 May 2021).
- 1.4. This Decision Statement, the Examiner's report and the draft Submission Cawthorne Neighbourhood Development Plan and the final Cawthorne Neighbourhood Development Plan incorporating the recommendations of the Independent Examiner, together with the supporting documentation are available on the Council's website at www.barnsley.gov.uk/cawthorne.ndp They are also available on the Cawthorne Parish Council website at: http://www.cawthorne.org.uk/Neighbourhood_Plan_9813.aspx

2. Decisions and Reasons

- 2.1. The Examiner has concluded that subject to the specified modifications being made to the Plan, the Cawthorne Neighbourhood Development Plan meets the Basic Conditions stated and other relevant legal requirements.
- 2.2. The Council accepts all the modifications and the reasons put forward by the Examiner for them. The Examiner's reasons and recommended modifications are set out in Table 1. There are three additional change which have been agreed with the Parish Council, which clarify that
 - A reference to Cawthorne Hall Museum Park and Gardens should refer instead to Cannon Hall Museum Park and Gardens.
 - The substitution of an amended plan to show the revised, extended Conservation Area as approved, and referred to elsewhere in the Examiner's report.

- A reference to Local Plan Policy H5 which is titled Residential Development on <u>Large</u> Non-allocated sites.
- 2.3. The Council is satisfied that subject to the modifications specified in Table 1 below, the Plan meets the relevant Basic Conditions mentioned in paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 4b of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, is compatible with the Convention Rights and complies with the provision made by or under S38A and S.38B of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004.
- 2.4. To meet the requirements of the Localism Act 2011, a referendum which poses the question "Do you want Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Development Plan for Cawthorne to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?" will be held in the Cawthorne Neighbourhood Area. As indicated above, it is anticipated that the referendum will take place in May 2021.
