

Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. This profile compares the Ward with the overall Barnsley figure and that of England where possible.



Demographics

Overall Population



Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in Dearne North has increased by 5.0%; the same as Barnsley overall (4.9%). The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more females than males within the ward.




Age Profile and % of Total Population


Main Language is not English

Barnsley's ethnic diversity continues to change. In the 2011 Census, 3 out of 100 people in Dearne North were from a Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) group compared to 4 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall. The 2011 Census is the most up to date national data available on ethnicity.

Indices of Multiple Deprivation 2015


This is calculated based on seven domains of deprivation, which in turn are composed of a number of indicators that are scored and ranked to produce an overall domain score.

Proportion of Dearne North Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) in 10% Most Deprived in England





The Seven Domains of Deprivation and how Dearne North Performs

Percentage of Dearne North LSOAs in the Bottom 10% in England by Domain




Index of Multiple Deprivation 2015 Dearne North LSOAs Relative to England (DCLG, 2015)





The percentage of pupils resident in the Dearne North ward achieving a good level of development decreased in 2018 with outcomes below both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018



The percentage of pupils resident in Dearne North ward achieving the expected standard increased in 2018 but remained below both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018



% of Key Stage 2 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in Reading, Writing and Maths Combined 2016 - 2018


















Life Expectancy at Birth

Life expectancy at birth for males in Dearne North is 2.4 years lower than for men in Barnsley and 3.9 years lower than England.


Female


Rate per 1,000 Population Aged 15-17 Years






Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)




Excess weight


10-11 Year Olds

47.3% of women in Dearne North breastfeed their babies at birth; lower than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.




Prevalence - Adults (over 18's)





No England data available for smoking prevalence as the Ward and Barnsley data has been calculated locally from GP records.

Local GP records 2013 - 2016

More than a quarter of adults in Dearne North are smokers. The current rate of 27.6% is higher than the Barnsley rate of 23.4%, but the lowest since 2013.

Dearne North's smoking related death rates have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England during the period 2011-2013 through to 2014-2016. However, the current rate is the lowest during the period.

Residents Living Alone and Aged 65+ Years



The 2011 Census showed that 14.8% of households in Dearne North contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.

Housing Tenure

Owned



Just over half of the properties in Dearne North are owned with a mortgage or owned outright. Ownership is lower than both the Barnsley and England rates.

Social Rented



More than a quarter of properties in Dearne North are social rented; this is higher than both Barnsley and England.

Dearne North has more private rented properties than both Barnsley and England.



Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more Dearne North households in Band A compared to Barnsley and England.

Total Crime (rate per 1,000 population)





There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.


The ASB rate for Dearne North is higher than both the Barnsley and England rates.




Average Speed by Ward (Mbps)




No Cars or Vans in Household
