Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. Overall Population



Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in North East ward has increased by 3.7%; lower than the rate of increase for Barnsley overall (4.9%). The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more females than males within the ward.




Age Profile and % of Total Population



Barnsley's ethnic diversity continues to change. In the 2011 Census, 3 out of 100 people in North East ward were from a Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) group compared to 4 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall. The 2011 Census is the most up to date national data available on ethnicity.




This is calculated based on seven domains of deprivation, which in turn are composed of a number of indicators that are scored and ranked to produce an overall domain score.

Proportion of North East Ward Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) in 10% Most Deprived in England





The Seven Domains of Deprivation and how North East Ward Performs

Percentage of North East Ward LSOAs in the Bottom 10% in England by Domain




Index of Multiple Deprivation 2015 North East Ward LSOAs Relative to England (DCLG, 2015)






The percentage of pupils resident in the North East ward achieving a good level of development decreased in 2018 and is now below the national average but remains above the Barnsley average.


% of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018



The percentage of pupils resident in the North East ward achieving the expected standard in 2018 decreased and is now below both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018




Attainment at the expected standard for pupils resident in the North East ward decreased in reading in 2018 and is now below the national average but remains above the Barnsley average. However, outcomes increased in writing and mathematics and are now above both the Barnsley and national averages.

The attainment 8 score of pupils resident in North East ward increased in 2018 and is now equal to the Barnsley average but remains below the national average.












Life expectancy at birth for women in North East ward is 1.7 years lower than for women in Barnsley.


The under 18 conception rate in North East is higher than the overall Barnsley rate. Rates have fluctuated during the period 2011 to 2015.




Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)



North East's under 75 cancer mortality rate (157.7 per 100,000) is higher than the Barnsley rate.



Under 75 mortality rates from respiratory diseases in North East ward have been consistently higher than the rates in Barnsley and England at each time point during the period 2010-2012 to 2015-2017. However, the current rate of 52.1 per 100,000 is the lowest during the period.




Under 75 mortality rates from cardiovascular diseases in North East ward have been consistently higher than the rates in Barnsley and England at each time point during the period 2010-2012 to 2015-2017. However, the current rate of 92.6 per 100,000 is the lowest during the period.




10-11 Year Olds



Just over half of women in North East ward (50.5%) breastfeed their babies at birth; lower than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.

Prevalence - Adults (over 18's)





No England data available for smoking prevalence as the Ward and Barnsley data has been calculated locally from GP records.

Local GP records 2013 - 2016

More than one in four adults in North East ward are smokers. Rates have been consistently higher than the Barnsley rates at each time point during the period 2013 to 2016. However, the current rate of 26.5% is the lowest since 2013.

Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)



North East's smoking related death rates have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England during the period 2011-2013 through to 2014-2016. However, the current rate of 376.3 per 100,000 (over 35's) is the lowest during the period.






The 2011 Census showed that 11.3% of households in North East ward contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.





More than 6 in every 10 properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in North East ward. Ownership is similar to the Barnsley and England rates.





More than 1 in 5 properties in North East ward are social rented; this is the same as the Barnsley rate and slightly higher than the England rate.



North East ward has more private rented properties than Barnsley but fewer than England.







Take up of Fixed Broadband





Adults not been online within the last 3 months




Average Speed by Ward (Mbps)




Average Speed (Mbps) in North East Ward


