




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Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in Penistone West has increased by 11.2%; more than double the rate of increase for Barnsley overall (4.9%). The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more females compared with males within the ward.




In 2011, less than 1 in 100 Penistone West residents' main language was not English, compared to 1 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall.



This is calculated based on seven domains of deprivation, which in turn are composed of a number of indicators that are scored and ranked to produce an overall domain score.


Proportion of Penistone West Lower Super Output Areas (LSOAs) in 10% Most Deprived in England





% of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018



The percentage of pupils resident in the Penistone West ward achieving the expected standard in 2018 decreased, although outcomes remained above both the Barnsley and national averages.



% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018




Attainment at the expected standard for pupils resident in the Penistone West ward increased in all three subjects in 2018 with outcomes now above both the Barnsley and national averages.






The percentage of secondary school pupils with special educational needs and disabilities increased in the Penistone West ward in 2018 and is similar to the national average and just below the Barnsley average.

Life Expectancy at Birth




Life expectancy at birth for males in Penistone West is 1.4 years higher than for men in Barnsley and the same as the England average.








Under 18 conception rates in Penistone West have been consistently lower than the overall Barnsley rates during the period 2011 to 2015.


Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)





Excess weight







Just over three quarters of women in Penistone West (75.2%) breastfeed their babies at birth; higher than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.



One in eight adults in Penistone West are smokers. Rates have been consistently lower than the Barnsley rates at each time point during the period 2013 to 2016. The current rate of 12.5% is the lowest since 2013.


Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)


The 2011 Census showed that 13.4% of households in Penistone West contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.










More three quarters of properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in Penistone West. Ownership is higher than the rates of both Barnsley and England.










More than 1 in 8 properties in Penistone West are social rented; this is lower than both Barnsley and England.

Private Rented








Penistone West has fewer private rented properties than both Barnsley and England.

Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more Penistone West households in Bands B to H compared to Barnsley. These figures are similar to England's.

Total Crime (rate per 1,000 population)























There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.



All crime figures relate to the period January 2018 to December 2018.









Access to a Car or Van


Mortality Rate from Causes Considered Preventable (rate per 100,000 population)
