

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Introduction and Purpose

Barnsley Council is continuing to change how we work together for a 'Better Barnsley'. We have ambitious plans to improve and grow as identified in our Corporate Plan for 2017-2020. This profile compares the Ward with the overall Barnsley figure and that of England where possible.


Demographics

Overall Population



Barnsley's population has been growing constantly since 2001. Since the 2011 Census, the resident population in Rockingham has increased by 0.8% compared to 4.9% in Barnsley overall. The increase in population is mainly due to more births than deaths and international migration. There are slightly more females than males within the ward.




Age Profile and % of Total Population


Main Language is not English

In 2011, less than 1 in 100 Rockingham residents' main language was not English compared to 1 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall.

Barnsley's ethnic diversity continues to change. In the 2011 Census, 2 out of 100 people in Rockingham were from a Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) group compared to 4 in every 100 people in Barnsley overall. The 2011 Census is the most up to date national data available on ethnicity.


Demographics

This is calculated based on seven domains of deprivation, which in turn are composed of a number of indicators that are scored and ranked to produce an overall domain score.

- LSOAs not in 10% Most Deprived in England




None of the LSOAs in Rockingham were in the 10% most deprived in England for both IMD 2010 and IMD 2015.



The Seven Domains of Deprivation and how Rockingham Performs


Percentage of Rockingham LSOAs in the Bottom 10% in England by Domain




Index of Multiple Deprivation 2015 Rockingham LSOAs Relative to England (DCLG, 2015)





The percentage of pupils resident in the Rockingham ward achieving a good level of development increased in 2018 with outcomes now above both the Barnsley and national averages.


% of Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard in the Phonics Screening Check at the End of Year 1 2015 - 2018






The percentage of pupils resident in the Rockingham ward achieving the expected standard in 2018 increased although outcomes remained below both the Barnsley and national averages.

% of Key Stage 1 Pupils Achieving the Expected Standard 2016 - 2018





Rockingham Barnsley England



Attainment at the expected standard for pupils resident in the Rockingham ward increased in all three subjects in 2018. However, outcomes in reading and mathematics remained below both the Barnsley and national averages. Outcomes in writing are now above the Barnsley average but remained below the national average.






The percentage of secondary school pupils eligible for and claiming a free school meal in the Rockingham ward increased slightly and remained above the national average but below the Barnsley average.


The percentage of primary school pupils with special educational needs and disabilities increased slightly in the Rockingham ward in 2018, remaining above both the Barnsley and national averages.


Life Expectancy at Birth

Life expectancy at birth for males in Rockingham is 0.9 years higher than for men in Barnsley.



Female

The under 18 conception rate in Rockingham is lower than the overall Barnsley rate, and is the second lowest during the period 2011 to 2015.





Under 75 Mortality (rate per 100,000 population)

Cancer





Rockingham's under 75 cancer mortality rates have been consistently higher than the rates for Barnsley and England at each time point during the period 2010-2012 through to 2015-2017. The current rate of 166.7 per 100,000 is the highest during the period.

Respiratory Diseases



Under 75 mortality rates from respiratory diseases in Rockingham have fluctuated during the period 2010-2012 to 2015-2017. The current rate of 43.7 per 100,000 is higher than the Barnsley rate of 41.8.

Cardiovascular Diseases




Rockingham's under 75 mortality rate from cardiovascular diseases is slightly lower than the overall rate for Barnsley (86.9 per 100,000, compared to the Barnsley rate of 87.0).


Excess weight

The proportion of 4-5 year olds in Rockingham who are overweight or obese (25.0%) is higher than the proportion in Barnsley overall (18.0%).


10-11 Year Olds

Over half of women in Rockingham (57.2%) breastfeed their babies at birth; higher than the Barnsley rate of 55.6%.




Smoking

Prevalence - Adults (over 18's)



More than one in five adults in Rockingham are smokers. Rates have been consistently lower than the Barnsley rates at each time point during the period 2013 to 2016. The current rate of 22.9% is the lowest since 2013.


Related Deaths per 100,000 (Over 35's)



Rockingham's smoking related death rates have been consistently lower than the rates for Barnsley overall during the period 2011-2013 through to 2014-2016. The current rate of 328.9 per 100,000 (over 35's) is the lowest during the period.

The proportion of women who smoke during pregnancy in Rockingham (14.9%) is lower than the proportion in Barnsley (16.8%) and higher than England (10.8%).

Residents Living Alone and Aged 65+ Years



The 2011 Census showed that 15.2% of households in Rockingham contained residents aged 65+ years that were living alone and could be at risk of social isolation.

Housing Tenure

Owned



More than 6 in every 10 properties are owned with a mortgage or owned outright in Rockingham. Ownership is slightly higher than the Barnsley and England rates.

Social Rented



More than 1 in 5 properties in Rockingham are social rented; this is higher than both Barnsley and England.

Private Rented



Rockingham has fewer private rented properties than both Barnsley and England.



Properties are banded into one of eight valuation bands (A to H, with A being properties of lowest value to H being the highest). These are decided by the government's Valuation Office which determines the amount of council tax to be paid. The chart shows that there are more Rockingham households in Band A compared to Barnsley and England.



There has been a continual notable reduction in the rate of Anti Social Behaviour (ASB) in Barnsley, as changes in crime recording practices implemented by South Yorkshire Police in October 2016 have steadily reduced the number of ASB incidents. Offences that would have previously been recorded as ASB are now recorded as criminal offences where applicable.


The ASB rate for Rockingham is lower than both the Barnsley and England rates.

Take up of Fixed Broadband




Homes that do not meet Governments 10Mbps 'legal right'



Adults not been online within the last 3 months




Average Speed by Ward (Mbps)

Rockingham Barnsley England





Access to a Car or Van


No Cars or Vans in Household
