Why is it important?

Gypsies and travellers may be more susceptible to poor health and less likely to seek health care. Gypsies and travellers should be able to access the same treatments and care as anyone else.

A report by the Traveller Movement, commissioned by the National Inclusion Health Board, published in January 2016 looked at how the living conditions of Gypsies and Travellers lead to poor health.
