What to do

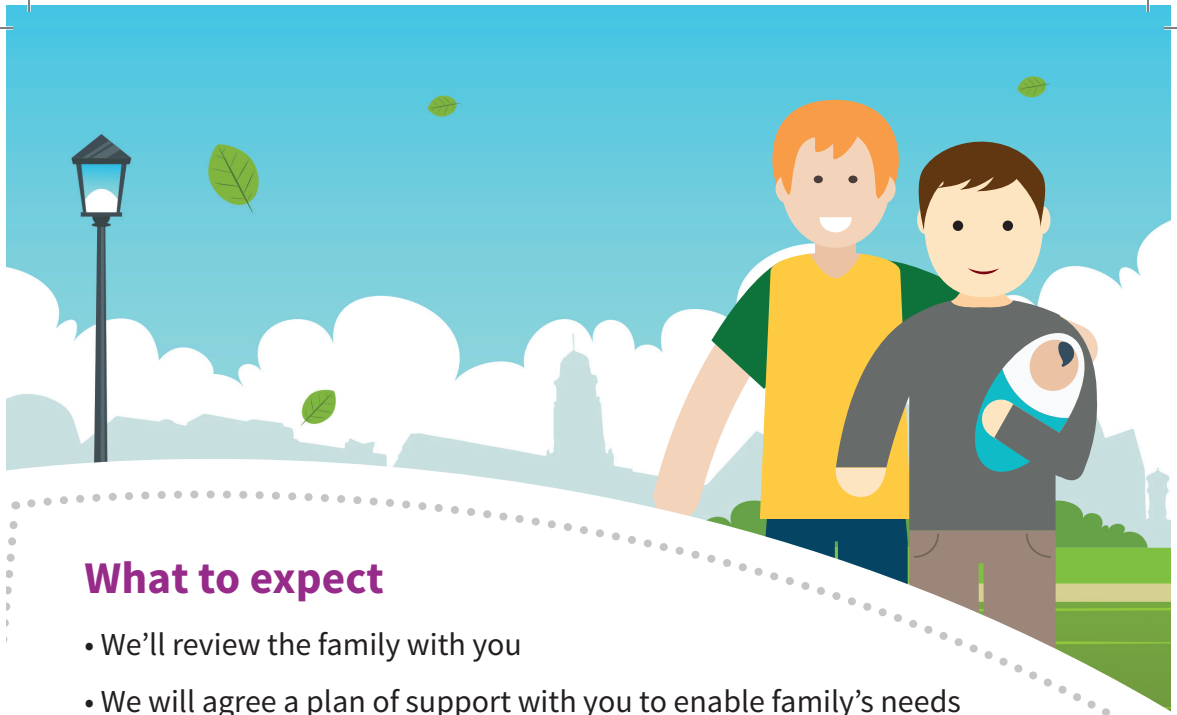
- Speak to your designated safeguarding lead to make them aware of your concerns
