Whats Happening Now? Ongoing Projects

Eldon Street Heritage Action Zone (HSHAZ)

Revitilising Barnsley's historic Eldon Street, the main gateway from the railway and bus station to the town centre.

With a four year partnership with <u>Historic England</u>, the fund will make a significant difference, improve the appearance of buildings, bringing activity back to the street. The project will contribute to a sustainable model for future growth and development of the high street and wider town centre.

The Glass Works

The Glass Works is transforming Barnsley town centre, the project brings shopping, dining, leisure and much much more!



The first phase of the £200m development is now complete. Barnsley Market moved into the The Glass Works in 2018. The following year, we saw the opening of the Library @ the Lightbox and Market Kitchen open. Market Kitchen is now open 7 days a week, late opening for food and drink.

The final phase will bring in new shops, leisure venues, such as Superbowl and 13 screen Cineworld Cinema and food outlets, plus upto 670 car parking spaces to the town centre. <u>Click here</u> to take you to The Glass Works website.

Digital Media Centre Expansion

Following signicant growth in the last 3 years, the Digital Media Centre (DMC 01) is kicking off it's expansion with DMC 02, which will help create over 100 digitally skilled jobs in the local economy



Outdoor Promotional Space

Why not promote your business by booking an outdoor pitch, we have various promotional spaces situated around the pedestrianised retail core of the town centre. Discounted rates can be negotiated for town centre businesses wishing to run a promotional campaign.



Promote your business through leafleting, flyers or any other other printed format. Leafleting promotions are allocated roaming locations only, the use of promotional equipment which require a stationary set-up, will require you to book an outdoor pitch.



Please Note - there is no power available at any of the outdoor promotional spaces; and the use of generators will require permission from us prior to booking.

How to Book Promotional Space

- In this first instance we would recommend you contact us by telephone or email to discuss your requirements, should you already have a date in mind we can make you a provisional booking.
- Simply complete the booking form we send you, and return with any supporting documents required.
- We may ask you for additional information such as a risk assessment if your event is particularly large or complex.
- Finally we will issue you with a formal written consent and permit and your good to go!

Charitable Street collections

Any person applying for a street collection license to collect in Barnsley town centre must obtain permission from Town Centre Services, email: <u>TownCentre@barnsley.gov.uk</u>

Under the <u>Police, Factories etc. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1916</u>, any organisation or person wanting to hold a street collection for a charitable purpose must be in possession of a permit at the time the collection takes place.

We will only grant licences where we are satisfied that applicants are fit and proper persons to make such collections

How to apply

Provide proof of identification together with proof any authorisation from the charity who is benefiting.

Online - you can <u>apply for a licence on the GOV.UK website</u>. You'll need to upload a copy of your <u>application form</u> when you do this.

Post - You can download and print our application form and post it, along with any accompanying documents that are required to: Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council, Licensing, Legal Services, PO Box 634, Barnsley, S70 9GG

What happens next

Upon receipt of an application consultations takes place with the police, and in certain cases the charity commissioners. We aim to process the application within 14 days.

A <u>statement of return</u> must be submitted within 30 days of the expiry of the licence. If you licence is for a period greater than 3 months, a statement of return must be submitted, ideally after each collection, but at least every 3 months.

You'll only be granted a licence if we are satisfied, that you are the fit and proper individual to make such collections.

Collections from public houses

A licence is required for collections from public houses where money is involved However if receptacles are left at a number of public houses and collected at a later date, no licence is needed.

Licences for Street Cafes

If you own a cafe or restaurant in Barnsley and want to place tables, chairs and other furniture on the pavement outside the premises for customer use, you'll need a licence

If you intend to serve alcohol outside, you'll need to speak to one of of our Licensing Officers on 01226 773555.

Apply for a licence

You can apply by <u>completing our form</u>, and returning it to roads@barnsley.gov.uk or Barnsley Metropolitan Council, PO Box 601, Barnsley, S70 9FA

Before you apply (Please read our guidance notes)

You'll need to provide a plan of the premises, copies of any relevant planning permission, and details of any interested parties.

The cost of licence is £452, which includes the cost of two highway inspections. The annual renewal cost is £225. We'll invoice you for this amount, which you can <u>pay by debit or credit</u> <u>card.</u>

What happens next

When we receive your application, including any additional information we've asked for, we'll consult the police and emergency services.

This consultation period and the issuing of the licence can take up to 12 weeks, from the time we receive all your paperwork.

Temporary pavement cafe licence due to COVID-19 (coronavirus)

Businesses can apply for a temporary cafe consent. This is intended to help get businesses back up and running during the COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic, this will:

- Last until 30 September 2021
- Allow businesses to place table and chairs on the pavement for business use (if you wish to serve alcohol you should contact our Regulatory Service team on 01226 773555
- Cost £100 (payment for permission to be granted)
- Do not need planning permission or scaled architectural plans

Business Rates

Business Rates or (non domestic rates) are a tax on business properties, such as shops, offices, factories, pubs and warehouses

Anyone using a building or part of a building for non domestic purposes has to pay business rates to their local council.

A proportion of the business rates we collect, together with revenue from council tax payers, government grants and other monies, is used to pay for the services we provide.

Reductions and Reliefs

Some properties are legible for discounts on their business rates; these are called 'business rates reliefs' - <u>read about the available reliefs, including how to apply</u>

How to pay your Business Rates

You will receive a bill for your business rates in March each year for the financial year ahead (1 April to 31 March)

Direct debit is the easiest way to <u>pay your bill</u>. You can choose whether to pay your bill on the 5th, 12th, 18th or 25th of each month.

You can also make automated payments by debit or credit card.

If your account is in credit, you can claim a refund, but we will only refund any credit if you do not owe any other amounts of business rates. <u>Claim a refund</u>

Joining Forces brings together key members of staff from the council and South Yorkshire Police. South Yorkshire Police's safer Neighbourhood Service, along with our parking service, markets and Town Centre Services are based in The Glass Works. This allows the delivery of our partnership approach from a central location at the heart of the town centre. You'll see more uniformed services under the Joining Forces banner, reflecting our joined up approach to improve security and safety, as well as providing security reassurance, support and advice.

Town Centre Wardens

The Town Centre Wardens provide a high visibility presence on a daily basis, they provide an ambassador role giving a welcome face to support and direct visitors to Barnsley town centre. The wardens focus on dealing with community safety issues, engaging with those involved in anti-social behaviour, environmental crime and identifying those responsible.

When to call 999

- When there is a threat to life
- Violence to a person or damage to a property is imminent
- A serious offence is actually in progress
- A suspected offender is still at the scene of the crime
- When any delays in reporting the incident may prevent the apprehension of an offender
- When serious disruption to the public is currently taking place or is likely to take place

When to call 101

- To report a crime that is not currently taking place and the offender is no longer present
- Where your call is a routine enquiry
- To make an appointment to attend an enquiry desk
- Requests for advice or provide information
- Lost and found property enquiries

Barnsley Retailers Against Crime is an organisation designed to aid in the reduction of crime. Working in partnership with Barnsley Council, South Yorkshire Police, SentrySIS and MRS Communications, the main aim is to reduce crime and anti-social behaviour in Barnsley.

BRAC helps bring all types of businesses together with the Police, Local Authority and CCTV monitoring to support each other in reducing business crime and anti-social behaviour in Barnsley. This helps create an awareness by warning members of prolific local offenders by utilisation of a radio network, intelligence meeting's and an online briefing and intelligence platform which all members can view and communicate on.

MEMBERSHIP PACKAGE

Hire a digital and secure radio from MRS Communications Ltd to Join Forces with the Town Centre Wardens and to gain direct contact with the South Yorkshire Police CCTV suite to take advantage of the new, high definition CCTV system in town centre. All the Local Authority town teams are utilising the platform and future events will be operated using this single, digital, secure platform and this will supersede existing networks.

The membership to the continuing growing network is **£10 per week**, providing you with un-restricted access to all of the above and advanced information sharing with key agencies in the town centre
