A planning application to link Higham Lane to Capitol Close has been dealt with and approved by the Council. The planning application reference is 2020/0040. The application is described as:

Highways works comprising the linking of Capitol Close and Higham Lane via a new roundabout, road realignment and widening works throughout, enlargement of existing roundabout located at Capitol Close and Whinby Road and provision of associated footpaths, combined cycle/footpath and verges
