Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Please can you answer the following questions regarding Adult Social Care in Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council, under the Freedom of Information Act 2000?

1. The lowest and highest (based on the standard daytime weekday rate) rates per hour of domiciliary care charged to the local authority for Adult Social Care commissioned through private domiciliary care providers.

2025/26 hourly rates
Lowest - £22.93
Highest - £32.84

2. The lowest and highest (based on the standard hourly rate) rates per hour of supported living charged to the local authority for Adult Social Care commissioned through private supported living providers.

2025/26 hourly rates
Lowest - £21.37
Highest - £28.70

3. When you anticipate re-tendering for:

a. Homecare services for Adult Social Care

We plan to start the procurement activity in May 2027 in preparation for a contract start date of the 1st of February 2028. This will be tendered via YORtender

b. Children's Homecare

We plan to consider procurement activity in 2026/27 early market engagement will be published via YORtender.

c. Supported Living services for Adults

This framework has recently been re-tendered therefore there are no current plans to re-tender. The current contract end date is 2031 with the option to extend for a further two years.

d. Supported Accommodation for Care Leavers 16-25

We plan to commission these services in Summer – Autumn 2026. This will be tendered via YORtender.

e. Extra Care services for Adults

We plan to start our procurement activity in July 2026, in preparation for a contract start date of the 1st of April 2027

f. Learning Disability services g. Mental Health support services

There are no plans to tender for these services.
