Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I am writing to request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 in relation to potholes and associated vehicle damage within your local authority area. Please provide figures for the most recent full calendar year (or financial year, if easier):

1. The number of potholes reported (monthly breakdown if possible).

July 24 = 134
August 24 = 107
September 24 = 165
October 24 = 201
November 24 = 187
December 24 = 236
January 25 = 871
February 25 = 1010
March 25 = 424
April 25 = 236
May 25 = 226
June 25 = 280

- These are potholes deemed actionable by the Inspector.

2. The average number of calendar days between a pothole being reported and repaired.

Not recorded

3. The percentage of reported potholes repaired within:

- **7 days**
- **14 days**
- **28 days**

Of the reports stated in question 1 of which were deemed actionable 89% were completed within 24 hours.

4. The number of vehicle damage claims submitted as a result of potholes.

5. The number of pothole-related claims accepted and the total amount of compensation paid.

Total number of settled pothole claims from July 2024 to June 25 = 11
Total settled amount = £2246.00
