Come along for information, advice, and support from a range of SEND services including

- Families Information Service for general information about SEND services, including how the Local Offer Website will help you on your journey.
- SENDIASS for school and education, including questions about tribunals.
- EHCP team for updates on your child's EHCP or how to start the process of getting an EHCP.
- Disabled Children's Team to help complete short break applications
- Positive Activities to talk about out of school activities and Targeted Youth Support.
- Parent Participation Officer to find out about getting involved and having a say.
