 - Please include your name, age, address and contact number on the back of your poster.
 - Entries from schools, brownies, cubs etc are welcomed - include details of school/group.
 - Email a scanned copy of your poster to katetownrow@barnsley.gov.uk or post it FAO The Mayor's Office, Barnsley Town Hall, Church St, Barnsley S70 2TA.
 - The deadline for entries is **Friday 28 April 2023.**

Winners

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- There will be a 1st and 2nd winner for each age category.
 - Age categories: 4 to 7 years, 8 to 11 years, and 12 to 16 years.
 - Winners will be invited to join the mayor in her parlour at the town hall on **Monday 15 May** at 2pm for an afternoon celebration and refreshments to receive their prize, certificate and commemorative medal.

- Entries must be the work of the name on the poster and of the correct age category.
- Entrants must be a Barnsley resident.
