- 2. Please provide details of the number of tickets issued to motorists paying traffic or parking violations fine in relation to this single street in the 2024/25 financial year, and what the violations were? (eg. parking, driving in bus lanes etc)**

849 Tickets issued, 563 tickets contravention code 25 Parked in a loading bay and no sign of loading, 149 tickets contravention code 40 parked in a designated disabled bay without displaying a valid blue badge,

- 3. Please provide details of the total income to the council from the number of tickets issued of motorists paying traffic or parking violations fine in relation to this single street in the 2024/25 financial year**

586 PCN Paid £23,811.00

- 4. What was the total number of Penalty Charge Notices (PCNs) issued across the entire council area in the 2024/2025 financial year, and what was the total income received by the council from these PCNs during this period?**

PCN Issued 8791 – PCN's Paid 6530 £265,007.19
