I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Could you provide me with details in connection with the cycle route/way (Active Travel Route [ACT]) from Stairfoot to Goldthorpe, mainly along the A635 corridor.

- 1) How much did it cost?**
- 2) What were the sources of all the finances involved?**
- 3) How many cyclists and pedestrians used the route prior to the 'construction ' of the ATR?**
- 4) How many cyclists and pedestrians now use the new ACT?**
- 5) Was a Cost-Benefit Analyst (CBA) carried out?**

- 1) £1.95m.
- 2) Transforming Cities Fund.
- 3) 12 cyclists and 80 pedestrians.
- 4) 36 cyclists and 93 pedestrians.
- 5) Yes.
