## Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

The total amount paid by Barnsley Council to Barnsley Chronicle (or its publishing entity) in each of the financial years ending 31 March 2023, 2024, and 2025.

2022/23 £154,527 2023/24 £152,082 2024/25 £204,603

A breakdown of payments for each year, if possible, showing category (e.g. advertising, public notices, subscriptions, or other services).

This information is not recorded however the majority of payment relate to public notices. Each individual payment would need to be reviewed to categorise accurately. There are over 250 separate transactions spanning the 3-year period. Each transaction would take at least 5 mins to review meaning the allowable time would be exceed. Should you wish to narrow your requirement we can consider your request

Whether any contracts or agreements exist between the council and the Barnsley Chronicle with details of start/end dates, value, and services specified.
