Directly funding/commissioned "Barnsley Riding for disabled association"
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Barnsley Riding for the Disabled Association were not directly commissioned during 2025/2026.

A small number of families receive personal budgets as part of a short break award, however they can use this to fund a provider of their choice and so no data is available in relation to the number of children with an EHCP that have accessed Barnsley Riding for the Disabled association through this type of indirect funding.
