of the Highways Act 1980. There is however a charge for inspection of works as specified above for Section 50 work.

## **Defect Inspection Fee**

If during a routine inspection performed at 1 month after reinstatement, 6-9 months after inspection or 1 month before the end of the guarantee period a defect is found, a fee is chargeable for each defect inspection regime which occurs, each defect inspection process incurs a fee of  $\pounds 120.00$ .

The defect Inspection charges will be levied on satisfactory completion of the remedial works. If due to poor workmanship the remedial works are unacceptable there may be additional inspections charged at the same rates.

Please be aware that charges will be made under Section 74 of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 if street works are unreasonably prolonged (for example take longer than previously agreed without permission).

## Charges for Emergency Works

If at any time during the life of the works it is necessary to carry out immediate emergency works to protect the public a charge for the actual costs incurred by the council will be made. This charge will be calculated as follows:
