## Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

1. The total cost incurred by Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council for the design, construction, and associated works of the new roundabouts installed as part of, or in connection with, the MU1 development.

The total BMBC contribution to the MU1 development was £74,206, the BMBC contribution to the new roundabout is nil due to the works being carried out by a private sector developer.

2. A breakdown of these costs, including (but not limited to) planning, materials, labour, consultancy fees, and any other associated expenses.

As above.

3. Details of any third-party funding, developer contributions, or grants used to cover these costs.

Approval was given to the acceptance of grant funding from the Sheffield City Region Investment fund (SCRIF) totalling £10.637M to contribute towards the M1 Junction 37 - Economic Growth Corridor – Phase 2 (Claycliffe).

4. The dates on which the roundabout works commenced and were completed. Please provide this information in an electronic format (e.g., PDF, Word, or spreadsheet). If any of the requested information is exempt from disclosure, please specify the exemption applied and provide any non-exempt material.

The roundabout schemes commenced 23rd November 2023 and Practical Completion has yet to be achieved but is imminent.
