3. What is the final cost to insure the roses with public liability per year?

£30,000

4. What is the estimated cost per month or per annum, for electricity for the rose sculptures

£38,000 per annum (estimated) although this cost includes the cost of running other lighting in the surrounding area of the roses as it is not separately metered

What security measures have had to be put in place to ensure public safety? ie; any cctv monitoring incase a member of public decides to climb up the structures, or vandalises them

New CCTV has been installed to cover the Seam area. 2 additional Town Centre Wardens have also been employed to provide increased patrols at the Seam, bus station area, Youth Activity Park and Base 71 (youth zone on Schwabisch Gmund way).
