I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested is exempt under Section 43(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 as disclosure would be likely to prejudice the commercial interests of the successful bidder. By providing details of the successful bid it would disclose into the public domain how the provider achieves value for money and give competitors an unfair advantage when bidding for future tenders with the council, or with other organisations.
