Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I understand that the council has regular SCANNER surveys of the condition of local roads. I would like to request the raw dataset generated from these scans or the equivalent laser or sensor-based road condition assessments.

I appreciate that summaries of the data are published on your website, but I am after that underlying data collected that is used to generate the summary statistics.

To start, would you be able to tell me what is the lowest level data that the council holds or is able to access from these surveys please.

The lowest form of data BMBC holds is in a HMDIF format which can only be opened with accredited UKPMS software.
