**Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

**Could you please answer the following questions about your library services.**

- **How many hours in total were your council run public libraries open to the general public (not just people with library cards) in a) 2010 b) 2015 c) 2020 d) 2024**

<b>Aggregate Scheduled Open Hours</b>	36,361.0	35,285.0	27,456.0	27,456.0

Aggregate Scheduled Opening Hours are calculated by multiplying the weekly published opening hours (as on 31<sup>st</sup> March) by 52 weeks. No hours are subtracted for Bank Holidays.

Actual Hours Open are for the calendar year.

The Aggregate Scheduled Opening Hours have been provided for each year, as the actual hours open are unavailable for 2010, and as a comparison for 2020 and 2024 due to the significant deviance between the published and actual hours open.

2020 was the Covid19 Pandemic lockdown year, so there were significant closure periods throughout the year.

In 2024, 5 libraries were closed during the year for varying periods, whilst the libraries were refurbished.
