Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Who is the current owner of the former Scout Dyke Activity Centre/Peak Adventure, Penistone (Kingswood) S36 7GF, are there any lease terms, and what is its current status since closure. Are there any future plans for development or usage? Is it on the market for sale/lease?

I can confirm the freehold ownership currently sits with Barnsley MBC and there is no lease in place due to the former operator of the site (Kingswood) having gone into administration and the administrator surrendering the lease back to the Council.

The site has been marketed and options for its future use are under consideration. These will be made public in due course when the council are in a position to make a formal decision on the future of the site.
