I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

On the 12th September 2025 a letter from Waste Management Team was sent out to multiple houses. The reference on the letter was 100050652616 and was delivered by Royal Mail 1st Class Postage to residents in the Rockingham Ward. The letter was sent out to apologise for 'the confusion caused with the wrong information being provided'.

How many households received this letter throughout Barnsley Borough? 9313

How many of these letters were dispatched by Royal Mail 1st Class Postage throughout Barnsley Borough? 4833

How many of these letters were dispatched by Royal Mail 2nd Class Postage throughout Barnsley Borough?

How many of these letters were hand delivered throughout Barnsley Borough? 4480

What was the total cost to the council tax payer to produce these letters including hours to produce, NI and Pensions?

We don't have this information. The waste collection service budget is not solely funded from council tax revenues.

What was the total cost to the council tax payer for the consumables, paper, envelope etc, to produce this letter?
