Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

Your questions and my findings are as follows:-

We have recently made the purchase of a former adult care home facility in the Hoyland area of Barnsley with plans to convert this into a children's care facility specialising in autism care including social/emotional autism with further provisions for children with learning disabilities and physical disabilities. The home aims to provide both residential and respite care and to understand the demand for both of these we wish to put a request in to support our capacity arrangements. The home will be managed and led by senior nurses from within the NHS with specialisms in the above. There is a professional history of taking services to CQC outstanding and we aim to replicate that here. The home has the potential to have 20 beds. This will be separated into two sections and will aim to provide the most personalised care available to children, young people and their families. We therefore require information regarding:

- 1) Number on waiting lists for such provisions**
- 2) Average length on waiting list**
- 3) Average costing per child based on staffing ratios/acuity**
- 4) A general overview of those with extended waiting times accessing care**

After extensive searches across services, we can confirm that we do not hold any data relating to your request.
