I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

1. Please provide the total number of roads or zones subject to 20mph speed limits within your area as of:

- (a) 1 January 2023 - 120 Roads, 12 Zones
- (b) 1 January 2024 - 120 Roads, 12 Zones
- (c) 1 January 2025 - 120 Roads, 12 Zones
- (d) 1 January 2026 - 120 Roads, 12 Zones

2. For each of the financial years 2023/24, 2024/25 and 2025/26 please provide:

- (a) the number of 20mph roads or zones removed or returned to higher speed limits; None in any of the stated financial years
- (b) the number of formal reviews or consultations undertaken concerning existing 20mph schemes; None in any of the stated financial years

3. Please provide the total cost of implementing new 20mph schemes in each of the financial years 2023/24, 2024/25 and 2025/26, if held.
