#### 1. Is BMBC aware of the issue(s)?

Berneslai Homes who are responsible to manage the housing stock on behalf of the Council are not aware of any health and safety issues with the current solar PV portfolio. We have received no notification from the regulatory bodies, emergency agencies, manufacturers, or contractors etc on any associated risks we need to be aware of in relation to the solar panels installed on homes. Social Landlords are required by law to ensure electrical installations are inspected and tested at least every 5 years. Additionally, any identified remedial work is completed within our agreed BH Electrical Safety Policy.

For the wider Council asset base (including schools and non-housing properties), Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council also as not received any notification from the fire service, regulatory bodies, emergency agencies, manufacturers, or contractors regarding safety issues related to the current solar PV portfolio. BMBC carryout 5-year electrical test on all assets managed by the council.

Berneslai Homes manages a number of homes that have solar PV fitted prior to 2020.

BMBC also managers a number of assets where solo PV have been fitted prior to 2020
