I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I request the following from your authority, covering the most recent 12 months for which data is held:

1. The number of Penalty Charge Notices issued.

7,221 issued.

2. The number of informal challenges received, and the number accepted (PCN cancelled at informal stage).

1,028 informal challenges received. 438 accepted.

3. The number of formal representations received, and the number accepted.

260 formal representations received. 82 accepted, 53 rejected & 125 were related to hire/lease vehicles and change of keeper details.

4. Where held: the breakdown of (2) and (3) by contravention code.

Unable to extract this information.

5. The number of appeals to the tribunal (London Tribunals / Traffic Penalty Tribunal) against your PCNs, and the number allowed.
