Re: Request for Information – Freedom of Information Act 2000

I wish to confirm that the council has completed its search for the information which you requested.

The information requested and our findings are as follows: -

I am writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 to request the following EV-related information from Barnsley Borough Council. Please may you provide me with:

1. Funding received

For each financial year since 2019/20, the total amount of funding your authority has received through EV infrastructure or charging schemes (if applicable), such as:

- **On-Street Residential Chargepoint Scheme (ORCS)**

2020-2021 - £100,000

- **Local EV Infrastructure (LEVI) Fund – Capital and/or Capability funding**

2024-2025 - £125,000 Capability funding

- **Any other government or devolved nation funding scheme specifically for EV charging/infrastructure**

2021-2022 – £275,384.98 Get Britain Building fund
